### Tentative itinerary, March 11-21, 2010 (ISU spring break)

Friday	Travel to Madrid, city tour.
Saturday	Visit Royal Palace and other sites of interest in Madrid.
Sunday	Visit important sites of interest in Madrid, take fast train to Lleida.
Monday	Meet faculty and students at University of Lleida. Overview of economic aspects of Spain and agriculture in Spain. Tour University of Lleida campus and research facilities. Visit winery.
Tuesday	Visit Guissona Food Corporation (fully integrated animal production cooperative)
Wednesday	Visit commercial seed factory and alfalfa dehydrating plant. Visit annual agricultural and machinery fair in Mollerussa.
