

## 2007 NOMINATION FORM FOR ISU ATHLETIC COUNCIL

According to the Iowa State University Athletic Council's Constitution and By-Laws, four of the council members are elected by the Faculty Senate. There is one three year term that is up for election this spring. Following is the charge for the Athletic Council:

"The Athletics Council shall advise the President of the University and the Athletics Director on matters relating to intercollegiate athletics. In this capacity the Athletics Council seeks to bring the view of the greater university community to decisions concerning athletics at Iowa State University. In addition, the Athletics Council has the responsibility, delegated to it by the President, to monitor the implementation of the policies and standards for the oversight of the intercollegiate athletics program of the University as established by Iowa State University, the Big Twelve Conference and NCAA Division I certification mandates."

On Tuesday, March 27, 2007, at the regular Faculty Senate meeting, 3:30-5:00 p.m. in the Great Hall, Memorial Union, one faculty member will be elected as a Faculty Senate representative to the Athletic Council. The length of term will be three years. The term begins in September, 2007. Any tenured or tenure-track or non-tenured eligible faculty member is eligible to be elected to this Athletic Council position. You do not need to be a Faculty Senator to serve. Any faculty member who is eligible for Faculty Senate membership may nominate candidates for the Athletic Council membership. **If interested, you must fill out the form below and return it to the Faculty Senate Office, 103 Lab of Mechanics. You must also be present at the Faculty Senate meeting on March 27, 2007 and give a short presentation of why you would like to be a member of the Athletic Council.**

Candidates for Athletic Council member must: (1) be nominated by a faculty member eligible for Faculty Senate membership; and (2) be willing to serve (sign this consent form).

Faculty who nominate candidates for the ISU Athletic Council: (1) must be eligible for Faculty Senate membership; and (2) may nominate more than one eligible faculty member. Self nominations will be accepted.
