



THE COMPASS PRIZES

The COMPASS Prizes will be awarded annually for the economic papers making the most significant contributions to the understanding and implementation of competition policy.

- **BEST PAPER IN AN ACADEMIC JOURNAL -- \$10,000.** The first COMPASS Prize in the amount of \$10,000 will be awarded to the economic paper published or forthcoming in a peer-reviewed journal in 2006 making the most significant contribution to the understanding and implementation of competition policy.
- **BEST (2) PAPERS BY PH.D. CANDIDATES -- \$5,000 EACH.** Two COMPASS Prizes in the amount of \$5,000 each will be awarded to the Ph.D. candidates with the papers making the most significant contributions to the understanding and implementation of competition policy in 2006.

Submission Criteria

While potential selections will be sought out, submissions for the COMPASS Prizes are expected and welcome, in particular for working papers accepted for publication in a peer-reviewed journal. For the prizes targeted at Ph.D. candidates, submissions must be accompanied by a brief note of nomination by the Ph.D. candidate's advisor.
