Subject: Summer 2007 ISBR Mentored Summer Grant Writing Program for Research in the Social Sciences

I am very pleased to announce the sixth annual *ISBR Mentored Summer Grant Writing Program*. This program offers one-on-one mentorship on grant-writing, through the submission and (if necessary) revision phases, summer office space at the Institute for Social and Behavior Research, and a month of summer salary.

All social science faculty members and P-17 or higher P & S with social science expertise are eligible to apply. One special funding opportunity is noted below, which has one eligibility restriction (date of hiring). However, other funding sources have been identified that do not have this restriction.

For individuals who joined the faculty at ISU after July 1, 2002, this program is eligible for funding through the “Research Grant Development Awards for New Faculty” announced by the Vice President for Research. The deadline for application to that program is February 28, 2007. A separate application must be made to that program which specifies that you wish to participate in the ISBR Social Science Summer Grantsmanship Mentoring Program.
