The Department of Economics at Missouri State University anticipates August 2009 openings for two full-time tenure track assistant professor positions in the areas of Industrial Organization and Econometrics, respectively. Preference will be given to candidates with secondary fields in either Health Care Economics or Macroeconomics. A PhD in economics is preferred, but ABD's in economics with a completion date on or before August 2009 will be considered. Grant-writing experience will also count in the candidate's favor. Applicants must have a record of excellence in teaching and a commitment to research leading to publications. In addition, they should have strong quantitative and communication skills and the ability to teach principles classes as well as to teach and conduct research in the primary field. The Department offers B.A. and B.S. degrees in economics and offers courses for a number of graduate programs on campus. The teaching load is nine hours per semester and will include principles and upper-division courses, with some of the latter being available for graduate credit in other departments.

We have a strong preference for online applications. Candidates may apply online at <https://www.missouristate.edu/academicopenings> and must state explicitly whether they are applying for the Industrial Organization or the Econometrics position. (Note that the Economics Department is in the College of Humanities and Public Affairs). Please provide a letter of interest, a current curriculum vitae, summaries of teaching evaluations and a copy of the most recent graduate transcript. These may be attached to the online application.
