**LOCATION:** North Carolina State University, Raleigh, NC

**DATE POSITION OPEN:** January 1, 2008

**APPLICATION DATE:** We will begin considering applications on July 2, 2007 & until a suitable candidate is found.

**MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:** Develop and conduct a research and teaching program in the Department of Agricultural and Resource Economics (ARE). The area of expertise is broadly defined and could include areas such as: agricultural policy, production and supply, technical change, land use, contracting, or marketing and price analysis. The successful program would build on the individual's research strengths in economic modeling with emphasis on empirical applications. The person filling this position will be expected to work closely with other faculty and graduate students in related and complementary research programs. Classroom responsibilities will include teaching (two to three courses per year) in the jointly sponsored (ARE and Economics) graduate program and/or at the undergraduate level. Advising at the undergraduate and graduate levels is expected.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidate must have a Ph.D. in agricultural economics or economics at the time of appointment. Preference will be given to a person with a proven record of excellence in research and teaching. Demonstrated ability in microeconomic theory and econometric methods is expected. The position requires the ability to communicate orally and in writing and the skill to be an effective teacher when working in public forums or the classroom. This position is a nine-month research (50%) and teaching (50%) tenure-track appointment.
