**LOCATION:** North Carolina State University, Raleigh, NC

**APPLICATION DATE:** We will begin considering applications on February 18, 2008 and until a suitable candidate is found.

**MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:** The candidate would teach agricultural law and other courses to both two-year Agricultural Institute student majors and to those students who are seeking a four-year Agricultural Business Management degree. Included among the courses to be taught are:

- two sections of ARE 036 (one section each fall semester and one section each spring semester);
- two sections of ARE 306 (one section in the classroom each fall semester and one section via Distance Education each spring semester); and
- one section of ALS 010 would be taught at a semester to be determined.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Applicants must have a Master's degree in teaching and hold a Juris Doctor degree. Preference will be given to candidates with a proven record of excellence in teaching and demonstrated ability in the classroom. Outstanding peer reviews and excellent student evaluations would be a plus. The position requires the ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing and the skill to be an effective teacher when working in public forums or the classroom. This position is a nine-month (3/4 time or .75 FTE) teaching position.
