Applications are invited for the position of Assistant Professor (Term) in the Department of Bioresource Policy, Business and Economics. This is a full-time, limited term (one year) position, beginning July 1 2008. Candidates should have research and teaching expertise in industrial organization, policy or business economics with applications to the agricultural, food and resource sectors.

#### **DUTIES:**

To deliver courses in agricultural economics at the undergraduate and graduate level. In addition to other duties that may be assigned from time to time, the appointee will deliver four courses in areas such as industrial organization of the agri-food sector, agricultural marketing systems, and agricultural, food and resource policy. These courses will be assigned in coordination with the successful applicant according to their qualifications and experience. The appointee will also be expected to contribute to the administrative and research activities of the department.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

Candidates will have a Ph.D. in agricultural economics or economics. Evidence of previous post-secondary teaching experience will be an asset.
