Special Issue: Rural Credit in China

Agricultural Finance Review, in conjunction with the China Agricultural University, is soliciting papers of broad interest dealing with Rural Credit in China. The purpose of this edition, slated for Spring 2008, is to increase the exposure of rural credit issues in China to AFR readers and scholars and to broaden the scope of the Journal. To this end the Journal will include invited scholarly contributions from a number of Chinese scholars with Dr. Guo Pei, China Agricultural University, acting as a guest associate editor. The Journal will consider any subject paper whether it is review, policy, theoretical or applied.

- **Topic areas** on rural finance issues related to agriculture, food, agricultural business, technology adoption, limited resources micro-credit and finance and others are welcome.
- **Papers with global reach** are encouraged, as are short case studies of successful or unsuccessful micro finance/credit programs. Issues dealing with rural credit and poverty are especially welcomed.
- **All papers will be peer reviewed**
- **Normal Page charges of \$75 per printed page will apply.** However, in the event that an author does not have funds available page charges may be waived partially or entirely at the request of the author.
