Assistant Professor of Economics

The Department of Economics and Finance at the Franklin P. Perdue School of Business at Salisbury University is accepting applications for a tenure track position of Assistant Professor of Economics.

Primary job duties include teaching 3 courses per semester at the undergraduate and graduate levels, engaging in scholarly activities commensurate with the school's mission, service/outreach to the University community, advising, and mentoring.

Minimum Qualifications: PhD in Economics (however, ABDs near completion will be considered) and excellent oral and written communication skills.

Candidates are expected to be able to use effective teaching and classroom management strategies which enhance the success of diverse learners. Preference will be given to candidates with documented excellence in both teaching and scholarship.

Applications received by March 17, 2008 will be given first consideration. The position will remain open until filled. Salary is competitive and commensurate with qualifications and experience. Appointment will be contingent upon verification of eligibility to work in the U.S. and is expected to begin August 2008.
