The Department of Economics seeks applications for the position of Department Head. Candidates for the position should have a research and teaching record meriting appointment at the rank of Professor (field open), evidence of academic leadership and administrative abilities, and a genuine commitment to diversity. PhD in economics or a related field is required. Teaching load is normally one course per year. The review of applications and nominations will begin on October 1, 2009 and continue until the position is filled.

The Department of Economics, which hired five new assistant professors in 2009, includes 29 tenure-track faculty and 95 doctoral students. The department enjoys first-rate facilities, including a well equipped Economic Research Laboratory, and has a healthy budget.
