TITLE OF POSITION: One-year grant funded University of Kentucky Post Doctoral Scholar- June 2009 - June 2010.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES: - The ideal candidate will be a scholar pursuing applied, policy-relevant research. Research interests may include, but are not limited to: rural health, spatial issues, in/out-migration trends, rural/urban relationships, targeted development, and entrepreneurship. This individual will work under the direction of Dr. Alison Davis. The successful candidate will be responsible for conducting research and developing decision aids on spatial depiction of production costs. This work includes the use of precision agriculture to manage risk and economic management as well as zone delineation procedures.

MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS: A PhD in Economics or a related field is required. In addition to strong economics skills, knowledge of econometric software such as SAS, Matlab, or Stata required and experience with spatial analysis and software recommended. Familiarity with government databases from the BEA, BLS, and the Census Bureau; familiarity with tools in Regional Information Management Systems (RIMS); and regional economic modeling software such as IMPLAN and REMI will be viewed favorably.
