POSITION/RANK: Assistant Professor. Two full-time, entry level tenure-track appointments beginning in August 2009.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Contribute to instruction, public and university service, and research/ scholarship.

Teach 12 credit hours per semester of Introductory Micro- and Macroeconomics and applied economics courses which contribute to the University's commitments to general education, diversity, globalization, Economics minors, and a program of Applied Social Science. Applied Microeconomics in such areas as Technology, Industrial, and Health economics and research methods are sought for one position; Macroeconomics, International, Regional, Money, Financial, and related areas of expertise are sought for the other position. Interdisciplinary collaboration with faculty in conducting applied research in business and industry, non-profit, and government sectors. Engage in scholarly activity and pursue external funding.

UW-Stout is designated as Wisconsin's polytechnic university and is a laptop campus. Instruction is expected to be student centered, focused on an applied approach in all of its disciplines, and use new teaching methodologies and technologies.

Schedule and maintain appropriate office hours and be available to students for consultation and academic advisement.

Attend and participate in meetings of the department and discipline. Perform other tasks as assigned by the department chair.

QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D. in Economics with an applied specialty is required, or ABD and Ph.D. awarded by the beginning of the appointment. Demonstrated potential to teach undergraduate non-majors and scholarly promise are also required. Interest in on-line delivery is a plus.

SALARY: Competitive with excellent fringe benefits.
